**RE: Aqua Ohio Installation of Water Lines in Meadow Wood Allotment**

The City of Green Engineering Department was notified late last week that Aqua Ohio would begin work on the new waterline in the Meadow Wood allotment this week (August 14). Previously the contractor for Aqua had delayed the start of the project, then at the last minute moved it again.

For residents directly affected by the water line installation, Aqua Ohio has sent notifications to each of you. While the City Administration strives to keep residents in and around the work zone informed through updates in our e-newsletter, text messaging, or letters, regrettably, this did not occur, due to the change of start dates.

**Meadow Wood Waterline Project**

*Project area: Water lines will be extended from Basswood to Meadow Wood Lane north to Spring Meadow Circle (see map)*

This project is being 100% funded and managed by Aqua Ohio, our municipal water supplier. The reason for the line is to connect two existing lines to create a closed loop, which provides better water pressure and water quality. Residents in Meadow Wood along the new waterline do have the opportunity to connect to the public water source, but it is NOT mandatory or required.

*Construction Timeline (subject to change) – one month*

- Week of 8/14 – mobilization, setting work zone and starting excavation
- Week of 8/21 – installation of new line
- Week of 8/28 – testing
- Week of 9/4 – lawn and restoration begins
- Week of 9/11 – lawn and restoration continue, demobilization of work zone
