A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO LAKE GEAUGA TREE SERVICE FOR THE MASSILLON ROAD RECONSTRUCTION (SOUTH) TREE REMOVAL PROJECT ("PROJECT"), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on October 23, 2008 and October 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, November 7, 2008 at 11:00 a.m. the City Engineer received and opened sealed bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends that a contract be awarded to Lake Geauga Tree Service for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

SECTION FOUR:

City Council approves the appropriation of Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000.00) to the Massillon Road Reconstruction (South) Account (403-8010-53632) from the Massillon Road TIF Fund.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:


